Paper & Packaging Company Launches Leadership Lecture Series at Marietta College with Topic of Taking Risks to Succeed

MARIETTA, OH (April 11, 2014) World Pac Paper launched its *Leadership Lecture Series* at Marietta College (Marietta, OH) on April 11, 2014 with keynote speaker William B. (Billy) Cyr, President & CEO of the Sunny Delight Beverage Company (SDBC). This inaugural lecture series occurred during the annual McDonough Leadership Conference. The World Pac Paper Leadership Lecture Series was started by Founder, Chairman and CEO of World Pac Paper, LLC, Edgar L. Smith, Jr. His vision to promote leadership among students in higher education, along with young & established professionals through a forum, which provides access to prominent CEOs as they share their insights on leadership was realized this spring.

Edgar Smith selected Billy Cyr as the inaugural keynote speaker of this lecture series because of his intellectual curiosity and daring actions to leave a Fortune 100 company, Procter & Gamble, to venture into the entrepreneurial space, while creatively gaining the financial wherewithal and an impressive recruitment of employees to run the company. Mr Cyr's keynote lecture was titled '*Take More Risks: Caution is Over-rated.*' Key takeaways included: 1) Most people overestimate the risk of complete failure 2) the consequences of failure are far less significant than most think and 3) the benefits of failure are much more significant than we think. Edgar Smith said "I was honored to have my friend and fellow Eagle Scout, Billy Cyr, with us at Marietta College as the inaugural keynote speaker for our lecture series." Billy Cyr led the \$400M leveraged buyout of SunnyD and Procter & Gamble's other juice drinks businesses in 2004 in partnership with the private equity firm JW Childs. He recruited 600 employees and raised more than \$250 million in debt financing – all in 90 days. His address to the Leadership Lecture Series audience was compelling, relatable, inspirational and demonstrative of leadership in corporate America and as an entrepreneur. Billy Cyr stated that "it was a joy to see so many highly motivated students, so focused on developing leadership skills. Leadership ability can make the difference between a mediocre effort and an outstanding one and Marietta College and its Leadership Conference with the World Pac Paper Leadership Lecture Series give students the tools to stretch them into being the best leaders they can be. It was a pleasure to meet these students and offer them the insights I have gained in my life." He was presented with applause and great admiration from the students, who were from approximately 10 undergraduate institutions including Marietta College, Wilkes University, University of Richmond, Birmingham-Southern College and other undergraduate institutions, faculty and local/regional/national business leaders.

The McDonough Leadership Center is one of the most dynamic leadership centers in American higher education today. The many programs, events and initiatives help undergraduate students gain a deeper understanding of leadership, practice their leadership skills, and in the process, grow as engaged leaders on campus, in the community and beyond. Edgar Smith, a Trustee at Marietta College, felt this prestigious center was the best place to house his vision for a leadership lecture series. His work with Gama Perruci, Ph.D.-Dean of the McDonough Center, enabled his vision to bring together top CEO's to a new intimate audience. Dr. Gama Perruci commented that "we were very excited to have the inaugural World Pac Paper Leadership

Lecture Series during the 2014 McDonough Leadership Conference. My. Cyr's presentation added greatly to the depth and insights that the conference provided to a national audience.
